## QUICK AND EASY FOUNDATION FUNDRAISING IDEAS

October is Founder's Month and there's no better way to honor our founder, Eternal Grand Master H.U. Lee, than to support the foundation established in his name. Here are some easy – and FUN! – ways you can raise money for the H.U. Lee Memorial Foundation. And remember... 75% of the money you raise goes back to your region for Regional Scholarships.

- Auction off Instructors/Leaders/Scholarship Candidates (all high school kids) for private lessons, yard work, chores, etc.
- Ask for \$1 donation from each student per testing. Encourage participation by pledging to match their donation.
- Put out a donation jar in your school with a sign that all money raised will go to the Foundation.
- During the month of October, with every transaction, ask for a \$1 donation.
- Sell water. You can probably get the water donated from a local store. If not, raise the price to include a donation.
- Get items donated from local stores and hold a raffle at testing.
- Tell your students that for every upgrade to Leadership, you'll make a donation to the Foundation in their name or their family's name.
- Set up your own fundraising website at [www.FirstGiving.com/21852](http://www.FirstGiving.com/21852). Reward your students who help raise money: Leadership students get 'star' for uniform, hours towards Level Up, etc.
- Host a movie/pizza night. You can easily get the pizza donated. Charge \$10 per student and have them bring their friends for free. All the money goes to the Foundation.
- Sell Foundation cutouts that can hang on the walls in your school. Your students make a donation for a cutout, write their name on it and put it on the wall. You can download cutouts from our website at [www.huleefoundation.org](http://www.huleefoundation.org).
- Have your instructors that are going for the next collars raise money, for example, level 1 they raise \$100, level 2 they raise \$200.
- Host a yard sale at your school. Invite your student's parents to bring their unwanted items to sell for the Foundation.
- Host a car wash or bake sale.
- Host a talent show with all the admission fees going to the Foundation. You can have pizza, popcorn and drinks for sale, too.
